HELVI LEIVISKÄ

1902-1982

Studied in and graduated from Helsinki Conservatory under the tutelage of, e.g., Melartin and Willner. Had a special interest in counterpoint and used fugues as integral parts of her large-scale works in an unconventional way.

IDA MOBERG

1859-1947

Studied in the 1880's in Helsinki under, e.g., Faltin and Sibelius, and later in St. Petersburg and Dresden. Was active throughout the 1920's but never received a pension, and lived her final years depending on the charity of friends. Main bulk of her compositions remains unperformed.

LAURA NETZEL

1839-1927

Born in Rantasalmi, Finland, but moved to Sweden as toddler. Composed a large number of published works under the pseudonym "N. Lago": songs, chamber music, piano music.
